American Recovery Act Program Funds (ARPA) Spending Update

Council voted to hire Curtis Deacon to repair the floor at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Due to the constant moisture, there have been challenges, which will now be resolved. The Town also purchased a storage container for equipment/supplies, and it is behind the Town's warehouse. The Real Estate Investment Grant is doing well, and we would love for more businesses and organizations to apply. Please contact us with any questions.

Recreation Economy for Rural Communities Grant

The Town of Buchanan is one of 25 communities nationally to be selected to receive technical assistance in planning for recreation as an economic and community development tool. The Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) is funding the applicants for the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Recreation Economy for Rural Communities (RERC) grant program.

The Town established a Steering Committee, and we are now working on the Community Assessment and will meet every few weeks to plan and then host a large community workshop in Spring of 2023.

Thank you to the members of the Committee who agreed to serve! They are Daniel Bratcher, Dr. Molly O'Dell, Katie Conner, Mike Burton, Jessie Burton; Rose Jeter, Melissa Lucas, Teresa Rothwell, John Mays, Jenny Wilson, Ken McFadyen, Eddie Wells, Harry Gleason and Susan McCulloch. We were asked to limit the number of committee members by the program manager, but these are great representatives. If you have any questions about this project, the Committee members are the ambassadors of the program.

The process is being convened by consultants from Revive Strategies, Just Trails, and the program manager from EPA. We are excited that representatives from federal agencies including the EPA, ARC, and the US Department of Agriculture – Rural Development will be onsite in Buchanan to learn about a community-driven vision for recreation.

This Master Planning effort can be used as a roadmap for project planning and implementing. We will share the Workshop date when it is finalized. We look forward to your participation and input during this process!
